Ejecting the disc




GETTING STARTED

STARTING UP

Set up your PSP™ (PlayStation®Portable) system according to the instructions in the manual supplied with the system. Turn the system on. The power indicator lights up in green and the home menu is displayed. Press the OPEN latch to open the disc cover. INSERT World Poker Tour disc with the label facing away from the system, slide until fully inserted and close the disc cover. From the PSP™ system's home menu, select the Game icon and then the UMD icon, A thumbnail for the software is displayed. Select the thumbnail and press the button of the PSPTM to start the software. Follow the on-screen instructions and refer to this manual for information on using the software.


NOTICE: Do not eject a UMD[™] while it is playing.

Use this menu to choose your game type, set options or view the credits.

Play Poker

The Play Poker option allows you to participate in either a Quick Draw or WPT Season game. Either Select an existing Player or highlight an "Empty" slot and press the S button to create a new player. See Create Player for more details.

Create Player

To create a new player, highlight an "empty" character slot and press the button to start the player creation process. When creating a new player, you can use the available sliders to customize your players Appearance, Face shape, Facial Features, Body, Tops, Bottoms, Shoes, Accessories and Personality. On the Create Player menu, move the directional button UP and DOWN to highlight a feature to change. Move the directional button LEFT or RIGHT to change the highlighted feature. You can also press the Square button to randomize the features. When you are satisfied with your selections, press the \infty button to accept the changes you have made.

Select a WPT Pro

You can choose to play one as one of the WPT pros. To do so, highlight an "empty" slot on the Select a Player screen and press the O button to bring up a list of WPT pros to chose from.























Edit Player

To change the appearance of a character that has already been created, go to the Select a Player screen, highlight the desired player and press the **©** button.

Quick Draw

For a quick game of poker, use the Quick Draw selection.

Quick Draw Options

- Game The game type. See Poker Games for more information.
- Location The arena in which the poker game is played: Select from The Illusion, Commerce Casino, The Bicycle Casino, WPT at Sea, Aviation Club de France, The Millennium Casino, Bay 101, Foxwoods Resort Casino, Borgata and Aruba
- Limit Set the amount one can bet in a single turn: No Limit, Limit, Pot Limit, Half- Pot Limit.
- Buy-in Set the buy-in for the tournament.
- Number of Players Set the number of players for the game.
- Opponent Skill Set the skill of each opponent in the game: Amateur, Professional, WPT All-Stars.
- Blinds/Ante Levels The blinds increase over time. Set the amount of time before each blind increase: 5,10,15 or 20 minutes.

2K Sports Tip Create your own poker game

If you want to break out from the norm and create your own game with a custom ruleset, use the Create a Game option on the main menu to do so. From the main menu select create a game, then select which base rules to use from Hold'em, Stud, or Draw. On the next screen you will be able to select which wildcards you want if any followed by game type and Hi/Lo hand qualifier etc. When you are done with that screen, back out of create a game and choose "yes" when asked if you want to save your game (This will save your game type with the name that you gave it). To play the game that you created, go to Play Poker, select your player, select Quick Draw. In the Game Type category at the top scroll to the left and your new game's name will be the first game type to the left. You can also host online games with your created game type.























Game Information Screens

At any time during the game you can press the **©** button and move the directional buttons right and left to view the Game Information Screens. There are eight of them in the game and you will need to move the directional button down on some of these screens to see the information for all of the players at your table.

WPT Chip Count Screen - Current chip count for all players at your table

Game Status Screen - Game type, location, prizes, level, stakes, blinds

Hand History Screen - All player actions for the current hand

Hand Statistics – Player stats for each player at your table (move down to see all players)

Career Record - Career money records for each player at your table (move down to see all players)

Game Rules - Complete game rules for the current game

Hand Rankings - Hand Rankings from low to high

Play Styles - Unique play styles for each player at your table (move down to see all players)

WPT SEASON



Ever wanted to be a professional poker player? Think of the fame and money you will earn as you battle your way to the top in WPT Season mode. Start out playing local small games and earn enough money to make it to the big World Poker Tour tournaments

- Satellite Game The Satellite game is a great place to start and earn money and a chance at a free buy-in to the Super Satellite game.
- Super Satellite Game If you want to break in to the tournament finale, you should use the Super Satellite to get a chance for a free buy-in. Be careful; the stakes are higher and the competition is smarter.
- Tournament Finale This game is for the serious players only. With a steep buy-in and tough competition, you better get some practice under your belt before you sit at the table in the tournament finale.

Once you complete the tournament finale of your current level, you will move on to the next level of play. Work your way through amateur and professional seasons to earn entry to the Battle of Champions and a chance to become the WPT World Champion!

WPT Invitational Events

If you advance to the Final Table of any WPT Season Main Event, you will be invited to a Special WPT invitational event. These special events feature a table of WPT All Stars to battle for tournament cash prizes.



























Achievements

While you are playing WPT under any Player Profile, you can earn trophies and Reward Chips by getting good poker hands, winning tournaments and other in game events. Your statistics, Reward Chips and trophies are recorded. Go to Achievements to view them.

2K Sports Tip -

Track your stats and improve your game. The best poker players pay attention to their past games and try to correct their mistakes. You can use the Hand Statistics Screen to do this. During the game, you can bring up your Hand Statistic Screen at anytime by pressing the O button. This will open the game information screen. Then, scroll to screen 4 which is called the Hand Statistic Screen. Here you can see your complete hand statistics for each character that you create and play with. This handy screen allows you to improve your game by watching your tendencies to fold, check or raise. You can also use this screen to see the hand statistics of your opponents as well. The Hand Statistics Screen works both online and offline.

Reward Chips

When you receive Reward chips, you can use them to purchase special items and clothing for your player. Use the edit player feature in the Player Select screen to adjust the appearance of your player.

POKER OVERVIEW



Blinds

At the start of each hand two "Blind" bets are put up or "posted." The player immediately to the left of the dealer posts the small blind, which is equal to half the minimum bet. The Player to the left of the small blind posts the big blind, which is equivalent to the minimum bet for the table. No other players put in money at the start of the hand. As the dealer rotates around the table so do the blinds. Blinds are posted at the beginning to assure that at least one player on the table has an investment in each hand.

Opening Bet

After each player is dealt two cards face down, players can look at their cards and make bets or "check" based upon the strength of their hand—or you can just bluff! Checking is essentially passing on your opportunity to bet, but staying in the hand. You can only check if no one raised before you in the current betting round. Betting begins at the person to the left of the big blind and goes around till all players have had a chance to bet, raise or check.

The Flop

After the first betting round is complete, the dealer puts three cards face up in the middle of the table. These cards are called the "Flop" and are community cards to be used by all players. Another betting round begins with the player to the left of the dealer.

























The Turn

Once betting has ended for the Flop, a fourth card is placed face up in the middle of the table, next to the Flop. This is called the "Turn". Betting then resumes from the player to the left of the dealer.

The River

Following the betting from the Turn, a fifth and final card is placed in the center of the table; this is called the "River". One final round of betting begins.

The Showdown

To determine the winner, each player may use any combination of the community cards on the "board" (table) with their two cards to make the best possible poker hand. In some cases, the best poker hand may be the five cards on the board. In this scenario, the players will split the pot.

Setting up your PSP™ Console for Network/Online Play

When connecting to the WPT network you must have a Network Connection setup through the Network Settings screen on the Home Page, or you can set it up in game. Here's how:

- 1. From the Main Menu, select PLAY NET POKER. You will be brought to the Network Connection Screen.
- 2 Select New Connection.
- 3. Name the connection. (ex. Home Connection or Local Hotspot etc.)
- 4. Scan for the local routers by selecting Scan.
- 5. Select the router by signal strength and by which one you have access to.
- 6. Leave the SSID alone and continue on.
- 7. Select None if the router has no security settings (Default on most home routers). If the router is secured, select the appropriate security type and enter the key or get the key/password from your local network admin before advancing.
- 8. Select None on the Authentication Settings screen (Unless your local network is customized with security).
- 9. For most routers select Easy on the Address Setting and advance to Saving the settings.
- 10. After saving the connection settings select the Connection you just created and advance to ONLINE GAMEPLAYI

TROUBLESHOOTING

If you are playing from behind a firewall, you should disable it before playing WPT for optimal play. Since we are storing your stats online, the game needs to have clear communication with the server at all times and sometimes firewalls prevent that connection from being made. Also, if playing behind a router, forward all of your ports for optimal play. This will increase the performance for server migration and ensure that your connection to the host is consistent.

Some routers and firewalls make it difficult for the game to synchronize.

This can be dealt with by enabling "port forwarding" on UDP 3658 on your router or firewall. The exact steps vary with each make / model but the following should serve as a basic auide.

- 1) Assign a static IP address to your PSP™ through your network settings. Typically the address 192.168.X.90 where X is specific to your router configuration (usually, 0 through 4) will work. The gateway will be 192.168.X.1 and the net mask 255.255.255.0. You will also need to get the DNS servers from your router's status page (via the web configuration utility) and enter those under the Manual DNS option in your PSP™ network setting.
- 2) Open your router configuration utility and find an option called "Port Forwarding", "Virtual Server", "Applications", or something similar. Refer to your router manual or web site for more specific information on what this option is called.
- 3) Set the port to TCP ports: 6129 and 57988-57999, UDP ports: 1026, 1027, 1257 and 54985-55021 and the type to UDP. Set the address





























to that which you assigned to your PSPTM in step 1.

If you are not comfortable modifying PSP™ or router configurations talk to a friend who is or contact customer service for your router or 2K Sports. WPT uses the GameSpy matchmaking service online. There is no hosting service for the game. The title itself acts as the host or the client, depending on whether the user creates the table or joins one. We will be renewing our matchmaking service with Gamespy on a yearly basis and there are no plans to terminate this.

Win Reward Chips and Buy Some **New Clothes**

During the game you will win Reward chips for accomplishing goals such as beating a full house or going all in and doubling up. You can view all of the reward criteria at the end of this list or by going to the trophy case screen. To upgrade your character's look, go to the select a player screen and select the character you want to upgrade and select "edit". This screen will allow you to purchase different clothing types for Reward chips. WPT for the PSPTM contains additional exclusive clothing to be purchased with Reward chips.

Play the Single Player Game as a WPT Pro Player

For all you fans of WPT out there, you can play as one of the Pros! Playing as a WPT Pro means that your character will look like the pro that you select and your character will have their unique voice instead of the normal player voices. The pro voices are definitely the most unique in the game, so try them all and hear how the pros play poker. There's plenty of smack talking to go around the table when you play as a WPT Poker Pro!

Fold & Skip Feature for Offline Games

When it is your turn to make a move during the single-player game, move the directional button to the left a few times and you will see the option for Fold & skip. This allows you to speed up the game and skip the hand if you don't like your hole

cards. You can't win a hand when you fold and skip but this does help to speed up the game considerably if you use this handy Fold & Skip feature. Remember, you are still losing your blinds and/or antes each time you use this feature.

Flaunt your Hole Cards after Winning a Hand Online

If everyone folds out of a hand and you win the hand, you have the option to show your hole cards to the other players at the table. To flaunt your cards to the table after winning a hand online, press the **right directional** button until the expose hand option is displayed then press the \text{\text{\text{\text{\text{button}}}}.} This is a fantastic feature for online play to show your bluffs and try to put other players on tilt when they see you bluffed them out of the hand with 7-2 off-suit!

Create Billions and Billions of Cool Characters in the Game

Yeah, that's a lot! The character creation feature in WPT is the most advanced of any poker game on the market. There are truly billions of characters that you can create in the robust character creation system. You can save up to four offline and four online characters at any time. To create some cool characters, select Play Poker from the main menu, then highlight an empty slot and press the 😵 button. Take some time to explore all the different options available to you. You will be able to come up with some great looking characters.







