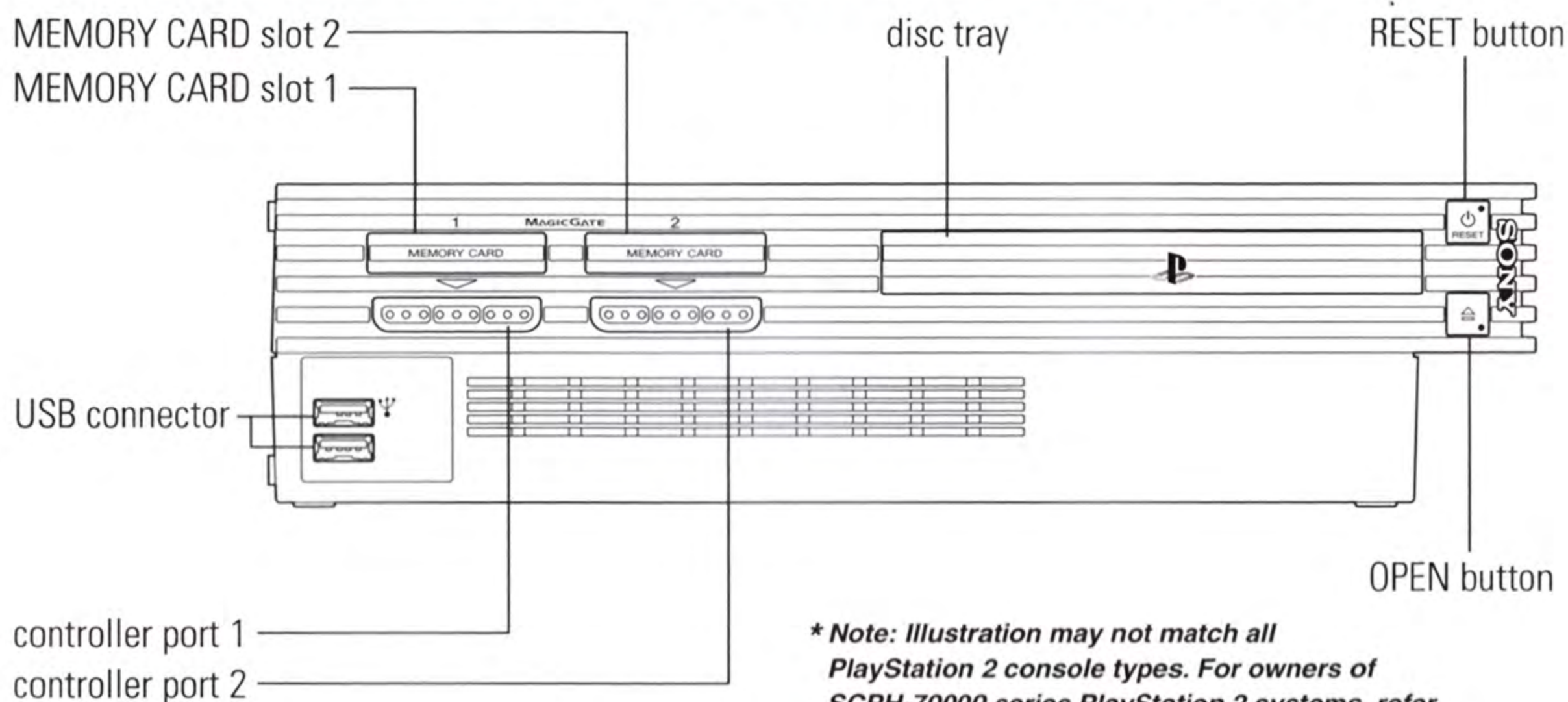

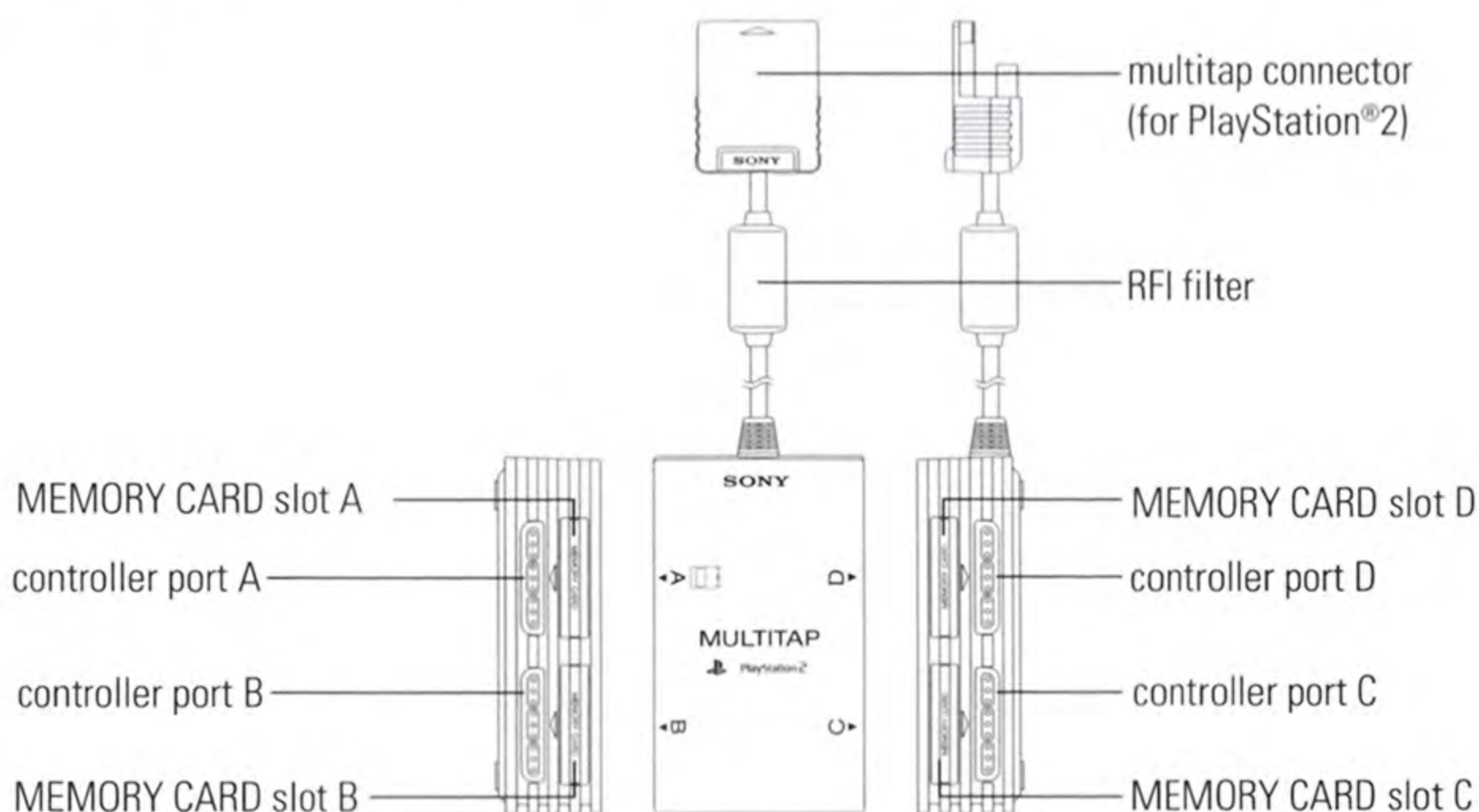

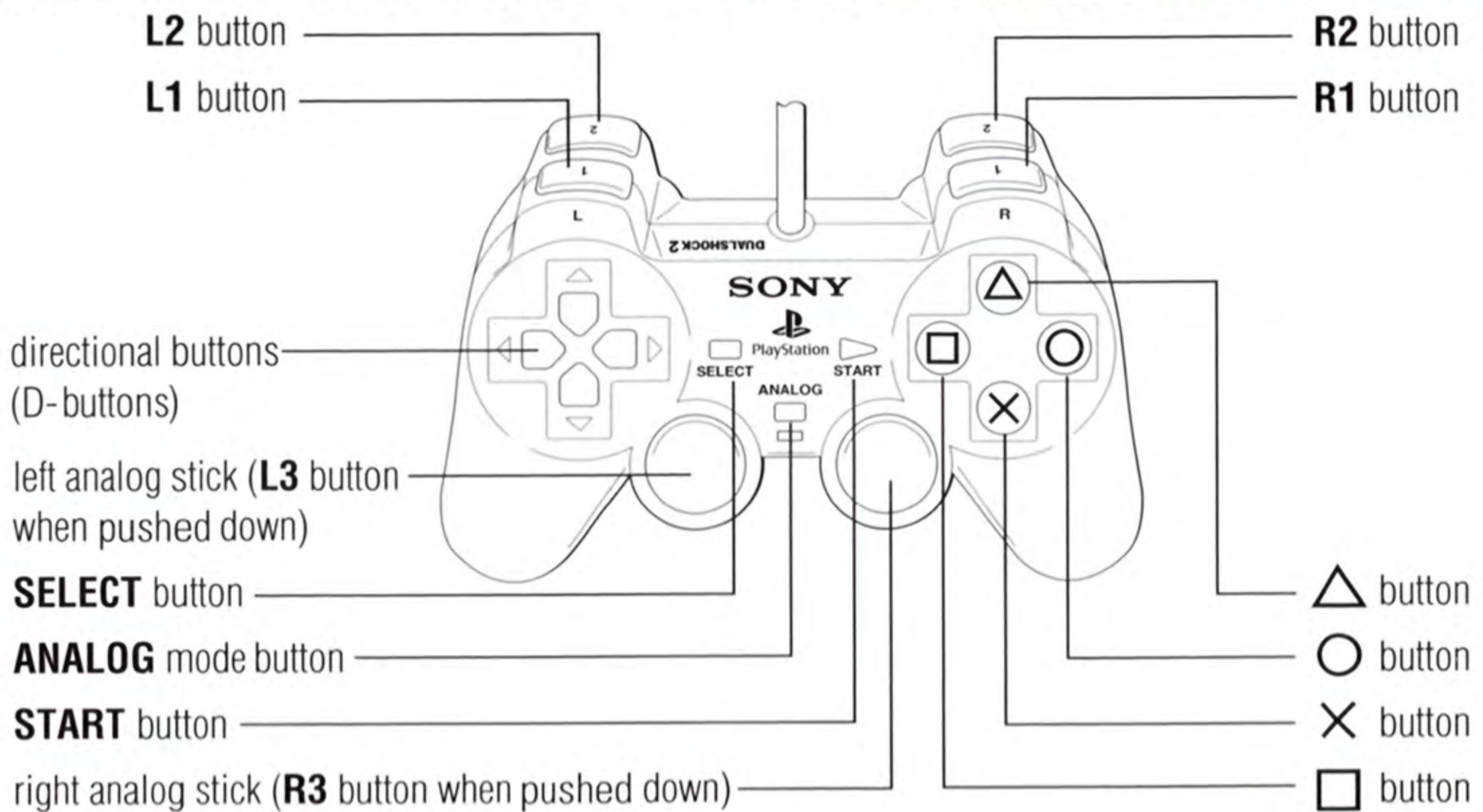
1. Set up your PlayStation®2 computer entertainment system according to the instructions in its Instruction Manual.
2. Make sure the MAIN POWER switch (located at the back of the console) is turned ON.
3. Press the RESET button. When the power indicator lights up, press the OPEN button and the disc tray will open.
4. Place the *Tiger Woods PGA TOUR® 06* disc on the disc tray with the label side facing up. Press the OPEN button again and the disc tray will close.
5. Attach game controllers and other peripherals, as appropriate.
6. Follow on-screen instructions and refer to this manual for information on using the software.

**NOTE:** When using the Multitap (for PlayStation®2), a controller must be connected to controller port 1-A.

## ADDITIONAL CONTROLS



With new swing and putting controls, you have more command than ever over your game.

### NEW SWING CONTROLS

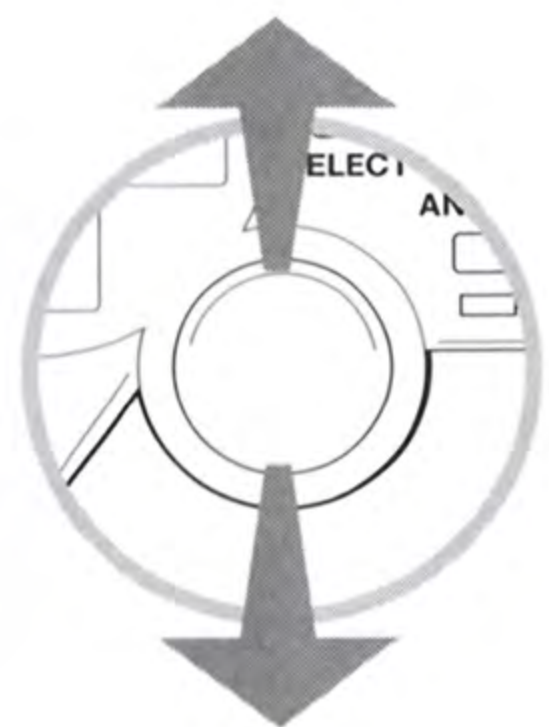
You now use both analog sticks to take your shots. The left analog stick controls the backswing and downswing, while the right analog stick determines where the club hits the ball—and the resulting trajectory of the ball in flight.

**NOTE:** You can switch the functionality of the analog sticks in the Controller Configuration section of the Pause menu.

### LEFT ANALOG STICK

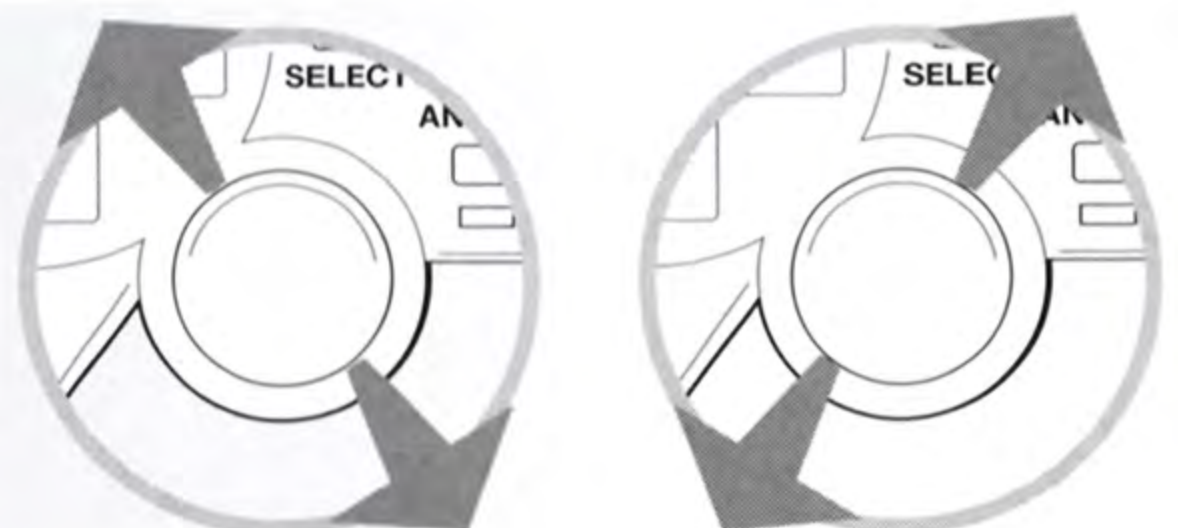
**To hit the ball straight:** Press the left analog stick straight  to begin your backswing—the closer you get to the peak of your backswing before pressing  for your downswing, the closer your swing will be to 100% power.

If the club's potential power is more than the distance of the shot, shorten your backswing to compensate. For example, if your pitching wedge can hit the ball 90 yards, but the pin is only 45 yards away, use half of your backswing.



**To hit the ball at an angle:** Press back diagonally and press up in an opposite straight line to hit the ball straight in that direction.

**EA SPORTS TIP:** In windy conditions, try compensating by angling your shot into the wind.

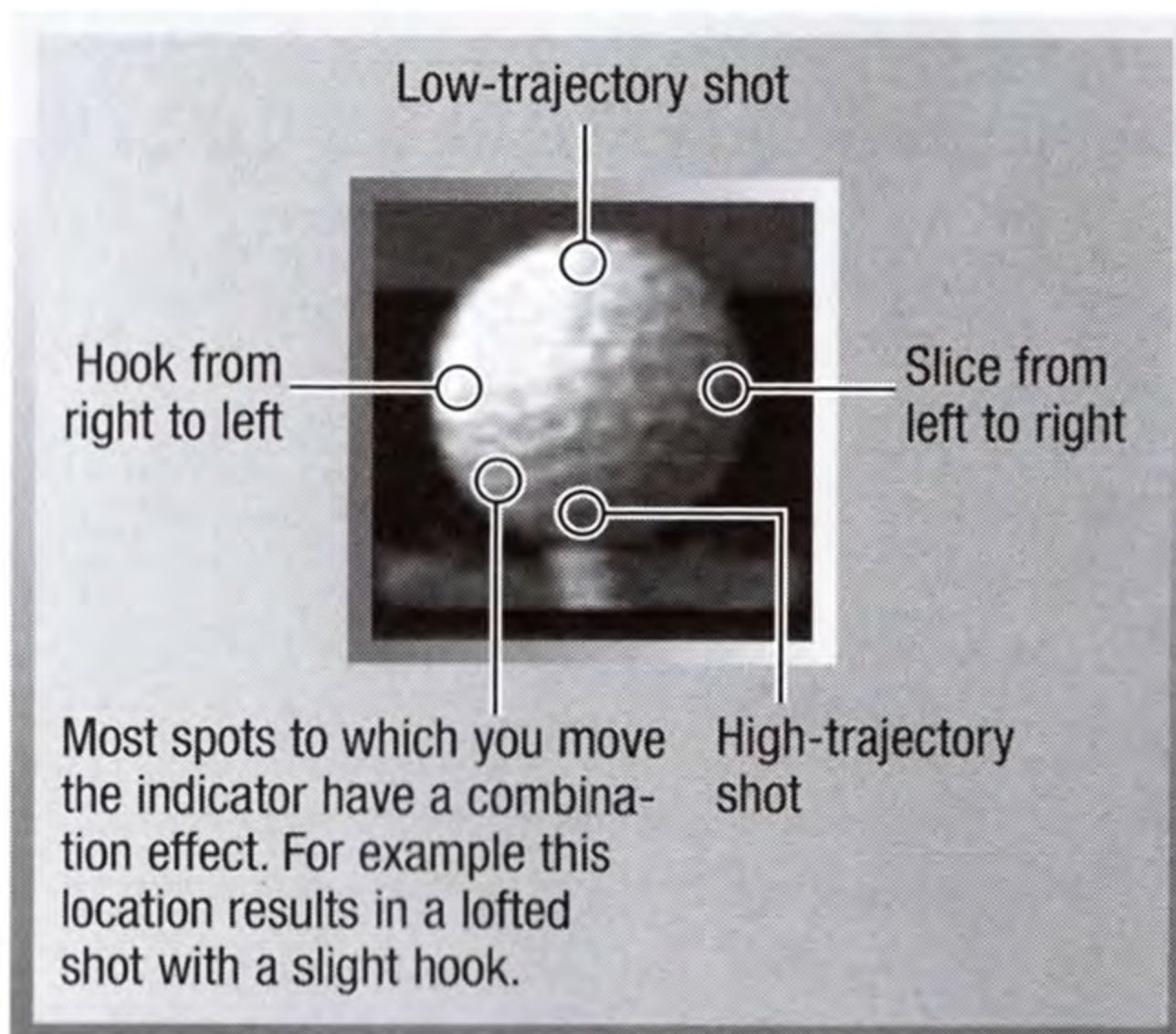


## SHAPE STICK

Where the club impacts the ball now determines the shot's trajectory. You control the point of impact with the right analog stick.

The golf ball graphic on the bottom-right corner of your screen is your guide. Move the impact indicator anywhere on the ball to dictate its flight. Wherever the indicator is located at the moment of your downswing determines how the ball is affected.

**NOTE:** Invert the Shape Stick in the Controller Configuration section of the Pause menu to reverse the effects of the indicator on the left/right side of the ball.



## NEW PUTTING CONTROLS

The new putting mechanic completely reinvents the way you set up and sink your putts. Like you would on a real course, you now need to read the greens and judge the distance to the cup before each putt.

### READING THE GREEN

Use the new green grid and camera angles to determine the slope and speed of the green before you putt. The faster the beads move on the grid, the faster your ball rolls.

Like the pros, you may need to scope out your line from different perspectives. These are the camera angles available on the green:

- L1** button Shows the angle from behind the hole. Press the left analog stick  $\leftrightarrow$  to rotate the view.
- X** button Lets you see the ideal line to the hole.
- button Raises the camera for an overhead view.

### SINKING THE PUTT

Like the swing control, you determine the power of your putts by how far you pull back on your putter. For example, on level ground, if the hole is five feet away and your maximum putting power is ten feet, you should only pull back half way on your putter. You can change the maximum distance of your putter by pressing the **R1** button or the **R2** button.

Also like the swing controls, the right analog stick controls the impact indicator. Move the indicator  $\updownarrow$  to add distance or take a little off a putt.

# PLAYING THE GAME

*Tiger Woods PGA TOUR 06* is easy to play but difficult to master. You need to be fully aware of every situation to be consistent.

## USER PROFILES

The first thing you need to do is create a User Profile and a golfer using Game Face. Each User Profile created can hold up to four unique Game Face golfers. Open the Game Face menu to create and manage your profiles.

## GAME FACE

The tool that revolutionized character creation keeps getting better and easier to use. Select Game Face from the Main menu to bring your golfer to life in every way. After your character looks exactly how you want, the Game Face menu is the place to increase your skills, purchase equipment from the Pro Shop, change your appearance, and more.

### My Appearance

Choose a category and use the sliders to endlessly change the way you look and, for the first time, the way you sound.

### Pro Shop

This is where you reap the rewards of moving up the money list. No matter how skilled you are, buying better equipment improves your abilities. Use the Pro Shop search feature to find what you're looking for in a hurry.

### My Skills

See the Experience and Skill Tokens section for an explanation of the new method of increasing your skills.

### Logos/Tattoos

Select and design tattoos for your golfer or clothing logos.

### My Animations

Be as funky or smooth as you want to be by customizing your swing using the My Swing feature and purchase special animations.

### In the Bag


Select the clubs you'll carry. You must have at least one driver, a sand wedge, a putter, and a 5-iron.

## EXPERIENCE AND SKILL TOKENS

When you hit a good shot, you earn Skill Tokens for that type of shot. For example if you hit a 300-yard drive down the center of the fairway, the Power and Accuracy Skill Tokens appear on-screen.

## IMPROVING YOUR SKILLS

At the end of an event, the Experience Summary screen displays how many Skill Tokens you've earned in each of the six categories: General, Power, Accuracy, Concentration, Putting, and Spin. Press the  button to enter the My Skills section and increase your attributes using those Skill Tokens. The General Skill Tokens can be used to upgrade any of your ten skills. The other Skill Tokens can only upgrade certain skills.

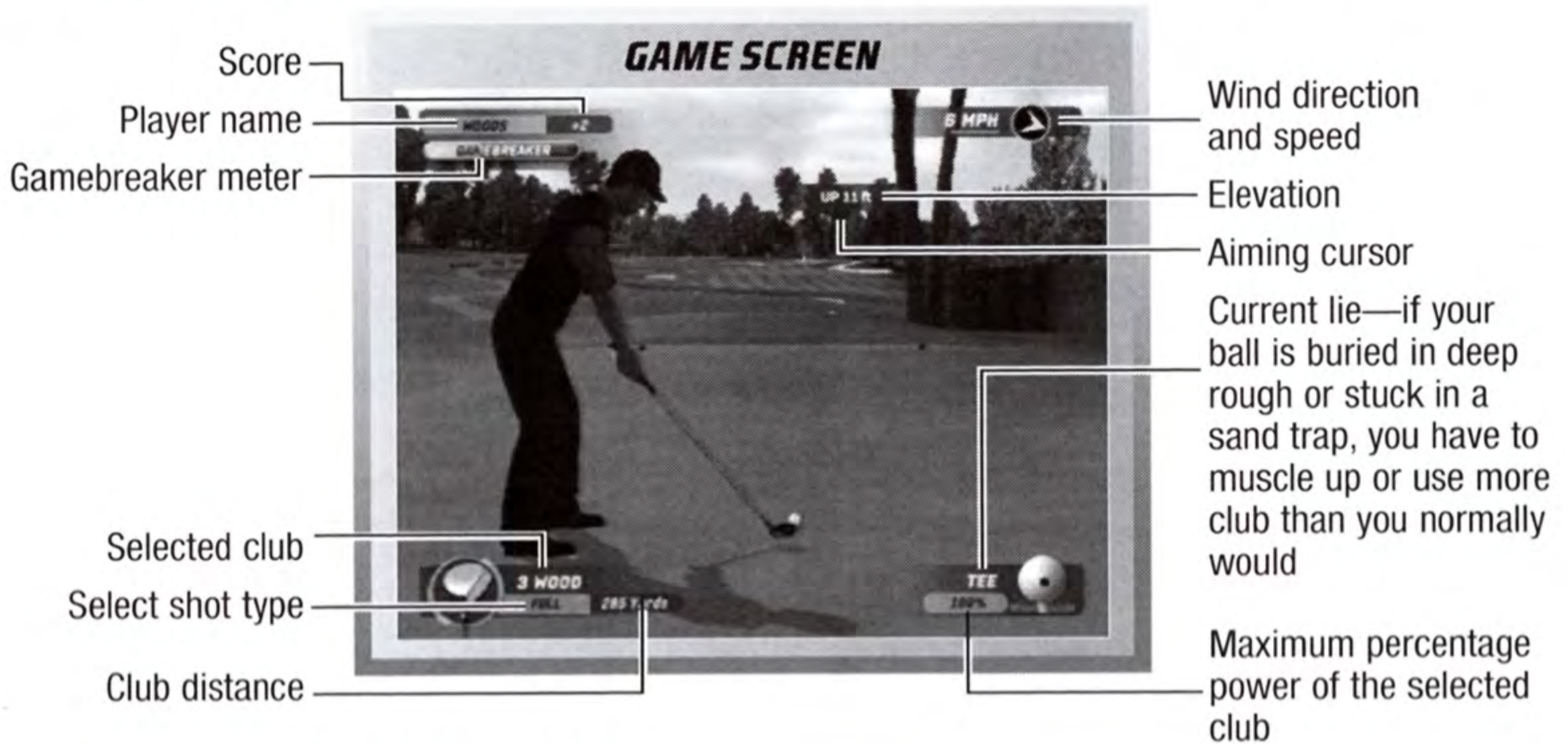
**EA SPORTS TIP:** A great way to earn Skill Tokens and boost certain aspects of your game is by entering challenges tied to that skill. For example, if your putting game is lacking, enter putting challenges and rack up the Putting Skill Tokens.

## MANAGING YOUR OWNED ITEMS AND BONUS MODIFIERS


As you purchase new items from the Pro Shop, you're now able to transfer Bonus Modifiers from your old equipment to your new purchases. The Equipment Modifier screen of the My Skills section is the place to make sure your Bonus Modifiers are in the right place.

## PLAY NOW

When you want to play a round with no strings attached, a Play Now game is the quickest way to hit the links. Set up your Play Now settings in the Options menu so they're always ready to go at a moment's notice.



### NEW GAMEBREAKER METER

Golf is all about confidence. When you fill your Gamebreaker meter, rapidly tap the  button during your backswing to trigger a Gamebreaker moment. You'll be able to hit the ball further and more accurately, while psyching out opponents to erode their confidence.

### NEW WAGERING

Back your challenges with wagers before any shot or round. Bigger odds are given to special accomplishments, so reap the largest rewards completing the toughest tasks.

## SHOT SELECTION

Choose your shot type based on each situation. The default club selection may not always be your best choice.

- |              |   |
|--------------|---|
| <b>Full</b>  | Set up a full swing with the selected club.   |
| <b>Punch</b> | Produce a low-trajectory shot to minimize the effects of wind, or to shoot from under tree cover.   |
| <b>Pitch</b> | Places the ball on the green with minimal roll from up to 60 yards away.  |
| <b>Flop</b>  | With a higher trajectory and less roll, this wedge shot has a maximum distance of 51 yards. Use it to fly over obstacles or to stick the ball on the green. |
| <b>Chip</b>  | A useful shot when you are too far away for the putter. The maximum distance for a chip shot is 40 yards.   |
| <b>Putt</b>  | When on the green, you putt the ball along the ground to the cup. The maximum putting distance is 120 feet.   |

## COURSE OPTIONS

When you play a round other than a Play Now game, you're given many options to customize the game. Most of the options are self explanatory. Here's some info about the others:



<b>Tiger Proofing Level</b>	Alters the course to make it more difficult.
<b>Reactive Tiger Proofing</b>	Depending on how you play, the course reactively increases/decreases in difficulty.
<b>Difficulty</b>	Selecting TOUR difficulty turns off some of your gameplay aids and forces you to reconsider aggressive shot taking. Your reward is increased earnings for every match you win.
<b>Specials</b>	These are specific shot criteria that reward you for accomplishing unique objectives like hitting the ball off a tree and making par to earn a barkie.

## SAVING AND LOADING

Be sure to save all your progress to a memory card (8MB)(for PlayStation®2). When you start a round or game mode that has a previous save, you're asked if you want to continue or start a new round.

**NOTE:** Never insert or remove a memory card when loading or saving files.

## NEW RIVALS MODE

Tiger Woods is on a mission to prove that's he's the greatest of all time. To do so, he's revisiting key eras of golf history to defeat every legend who's ever held that title. You are his rival and the only person standing in his way. Find him, stop him, and claim the title of greatest ever for yourself.

Each era contains a unique set of events and challenges, and its own pro shop full of time-specific equipment and apparel. Once you complete a certain number of events, that era's greatest player will come looking for you. With Tiger Woods breathing down your neck every step of the way, it won't be easy to maintain your composure.

### THE CLUB HOUSE

Navigate through Rivals mode in the Club House. It's where you go to get challenged, visit the era-specific Pro Shop, review your trophies, and more.

Go to the front desk to check out the challenge board and call out your rivals to begin your quest to become the greatest of all time.

## OTHER GAME MODES
